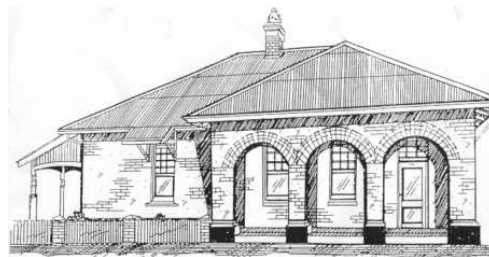

Nhanda is a language of WA, once spoken along a coastal strip 20-100 km wide from present day Geraldton north to the Murchison River. Nhanda is one of the least studied languages of WA and is on the verge of extinction.. Presently, Nhanda is spoken by a handful of people, at most.

*The Kangaroos Who Wanted to Become People*  
*Barn-Barn Barlala, The Bush Trickster.*

▪ **The Badudu Stories: Teaching Ideas** **\$27.95**

May O'Brien's Badudu Stories present four new stories which focus on Aboriginal children learning how to read and write English (their second language). The *Teaching Ideas* provide a context and help interpret the stories. They raise awareness of difficulties with language and behaviour encountered by Aboriginal children and others from non-English speaking backgrounds and help in developing literacy skills.

These are true stories based on the personal experiences of May O'Brien at the Mount Margaret Mission where she lived between the ages of five and seventeen. In the language of the Wongutha people, *Badudu* means 'not what it seems'. May gave this name to the series because all her stories contain an element of confusion about use of words in English, which mean something different from their literal meanings. Titles are:

*What Do You Say?* *Which Jack?*  
*Too Big For Your Boots* *Smartie Pants*
